Programme developed based on a dynamic leadership framework which brings out leadership interaction with key components of the health system.

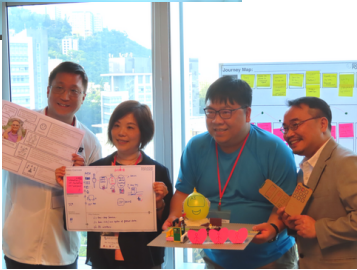

- Obtained a degree from a university in Hong Kong or taken a degree programme of which the medium of instruction was English; or Achieved scores in the following English Language tests as indicated:
 - i. TOEFL: 550 (Paper-based)/ 79 (Internet-based);
 - ii. IELTS (Academic): 6.5;
 - iii. GMAT (Verbal): Band 21
